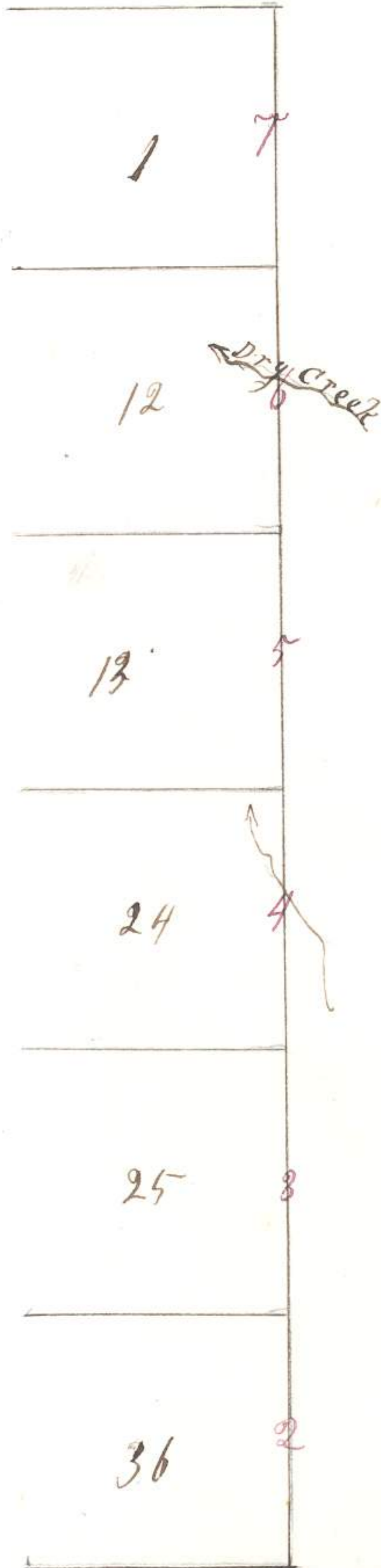

The lands in this Township are well adapted to stock raising, along the water courses the lands are very rich, yielding abundant harvest whenever brought under cultivation.

The up lands are thickly covered with buck grass. Valuable Clinias have been located along the streams and in many places on the up lands. Therefore the Township should be subdivided.
