 " " 4 " " " S, 60° E, 20 "

This line passes through  
 thick timber Fir, Larch  
 and Pine Undergrowth same

The last half descends toward  
the Walla Walla River, North  
Branch.

We found the snow too  
deep to proceed further with  
this line consequently the  
remaining 5 miles of the  
Eastern boundary of this  
Township remains to be  
run at some future time.

This Township ought  
to be subdivided and at  
least one tier of sections on  
the West of T5N R88E  
since the lands are valuable for  
the timber, a large  
District of Country in  
Oregon & Washington Territory  
are dependant on these  
Mountains for their timber

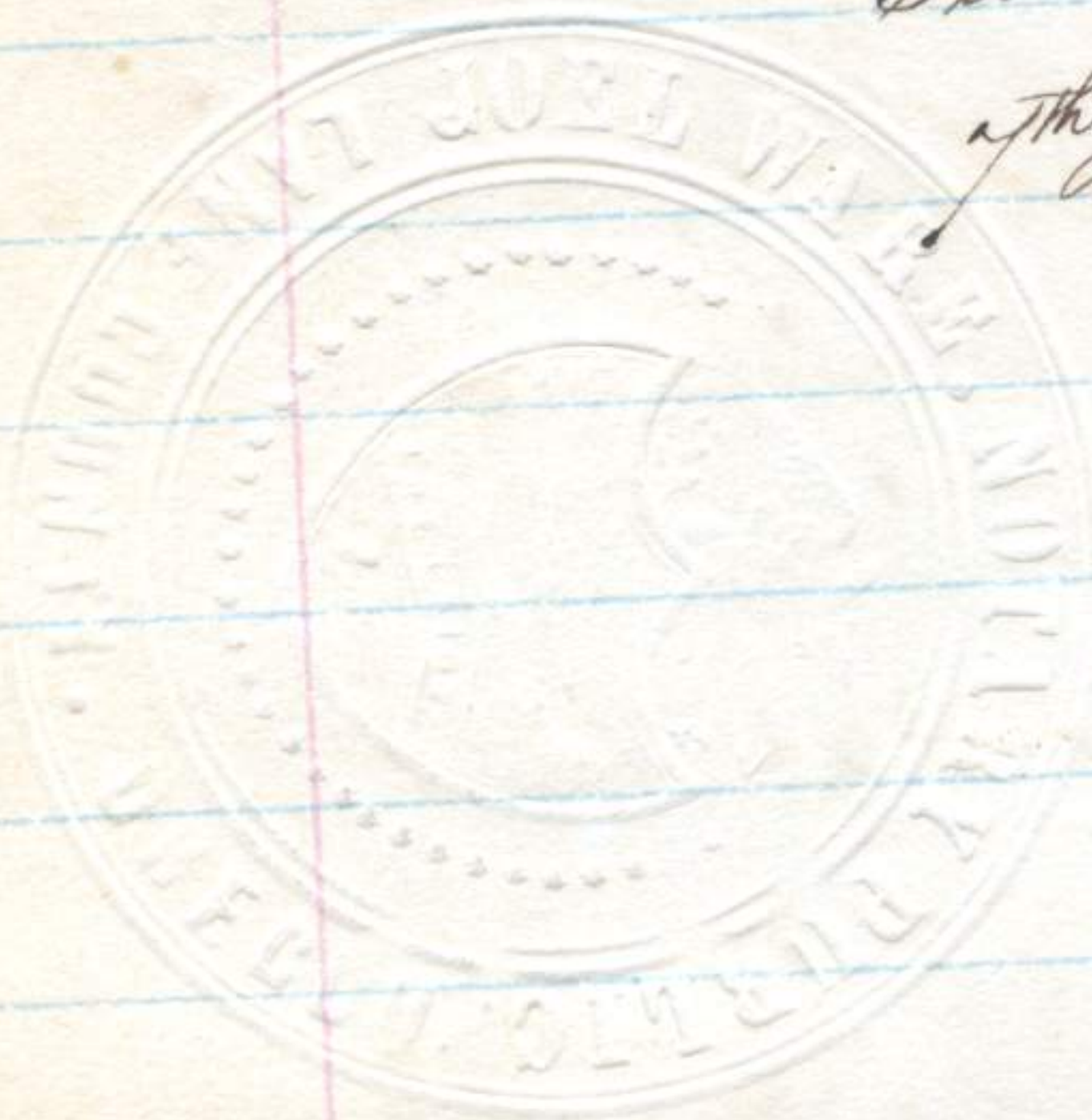
