General Description

The larger part of this Township is undulating or slightly rolling. Much is nearly or quite level and a small part in the S. W. is quite broken. Soil is mostly 2' rate, large part first rate, also a considerable part 3' rate. Probably about $\frac{1}{3}$ is covered with Pine Tamarack & Fir timber. Large part is excellent farming land. There are some 12 or 15 settlers in this Township and should be subdivided.



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Diagram of T. No 5 South R. 31 East




*Diagram of T.**R.*
