Between Ranges 36 and 37 East Township 6 North.

Yakama Bluff, north end N. $66^{\circ}25'W$. dist. about 58 miles. To West end of projecting ridge on south side of Cottonwood Creek S. $55^{\circ}06'E$. dist. $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles. To center of last bluff on Cottonwood Creek S. $77^{\circ}54'W$. distance 65 chs. Land gently sloping from foot of mountains, rich soil, all under cultivation no timber. Deposited a quantity of charcoal. Erected a Cottonwood post of prescribed size & marking, built mound and dug pits etc.

November 25. 1863.

South on East Boundary of Section 13.
 Va. $20^{\circ}30'E$.

27.46 Through cultivated field of Mr Swasey To Boundary between Oregon & Washington and 35th mile monument, Bearing to Mr Posters chimney N. $21^{\circ}19'E$, about 85 chains. To ridge of Catholic Seminary N. $48^{\circ}21'W$. dist 7 miles. To ridge of F. Shealons house S. $61^{\circ}03'E$. dist. 60 chs. To upper or SW. corner of ditch S. $47^{\circ}42'W$. dist 50 chs. made excavation 4 feet deep. Deposited cows head & quantity of bones glass bottle and charred stakes. Planted a seasoned heavy Cottonwood post 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet long & 15 in. dia top levelled, ground end charred, sides squared, and marked in deeply cut characters, on the North face "W." on the south face "O" on the East "46.L. 1864." and on the West face 35. "N" mound about 8 feet square & 4 feet high tapering to post. Deep quadrangular trench, 4 pits etc.

Built earthen mound about properly marked post, Dug trench pits etc. Land generally level. Soil alkaline and covered with sage brush, April 5. 1864.

Center of distant mountain peak N. 62° 34' W. dist say 46 miles. Center of rock on Mt. side S. 20° 38' W. distance 5 miles. Some pine tree on distant mountain side S. 22° 19' E. distant 15 miles.

Deposited bones and erected earthen mound with post in center pits etc marked T. 6. N. R. 35. E. S. 18. and T. 6. N. R. 34. E. S. 13.

Land rolling prairie covered with bunch grass. Sold 2nd + 3rd rate

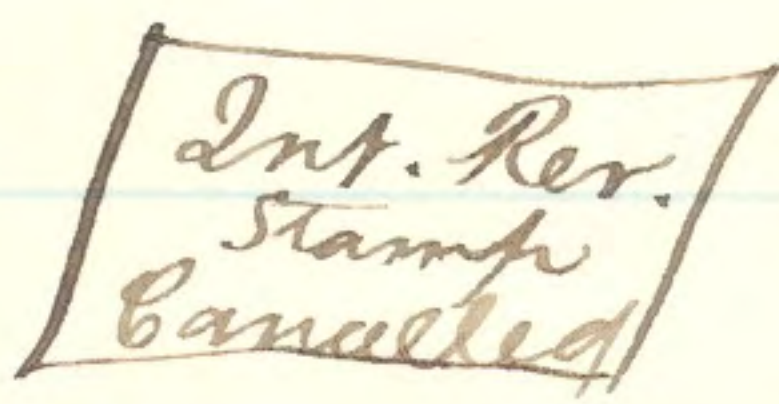
