	General description.
	The quality of land in this Township is good, 2nd rate,
	gently rolling prairie, covered with a thick growth of
	Bunch grass.
	The Umatilla River, which flows through the Township from
	S.E. to N.W., is a fine stream of clear, fresh water,
	150 links wide. Its banks are covered with Balm,
	Cottonwood, Birch, Alder and Crabapple timber with
	thick undergrowth of rose bushes.
	There are about 40 settlers in this Township.
