40.00 Set  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. post.

Drove charred stake; dug pits & raised mound, as per instructions.

51.00 Wagon road, course N.E.

51.25 One branch Tum Lum River, 15 lks. wide, course E. of N.

80.00 Set post Cor. for Secs. 25, 26, 30 & 31. Drove charred stake; dug pits & raised mound, as per instructions.

Land; gently rolling.

Soil; last  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile, 1st rate.

N. on E. Bdy. of Sec. 25.

Var. 21°E.

11.50 Enter field, course fence, E. of N.

40.00 Set  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. post on a level. Drove charred stake; dug pits and raised mound, as per instructions.

65.50 Crossed partition fence, course E. & W.

67.70 Another branch of the Tum Lum, 15 lks. wide, course E. of N.

80.00 Set post Cor. for Secs. 24, 25, <sup>30?</sup> 13 & 19, on a level. Drove charred stake; dug pits & raised mound, as per instruct.

Land; level.

Soil; 1st rate.

N. on E. Bdy. of Secs. 24.

40.00 Set  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. post, on level. Drove charred stake; dug pits & raised mound, as per instructions.

56.25 Branch of Tum Lum, course N. of W.

57.75 Same " " " " " "

60.50 Leave the same course W. of N. & leave field.

80.00 Set post Cor. for Secs. 13, 24, 18 & 19 on level, in road, course of road N.W.
