

TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 38 EAST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, SUBDIVISION OF SECTIONS AND SURVEY

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the Oregon and Washington State boundary, and portions of the south, east, and west boundaries and subdivision lines, T. 6 N., R. 38 E., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, the subdivision of sections 14, 15, 20, 21, 22 and 26, and the metes-and-bounds survey of the thread of Henry Creek in sections 19, 20, 29 and 30.

Except as shown hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved September 1, 1873.

The survey was executed by Richard L. Jansor, Philip S. Griffin, Larry D. Holmes and Richard R. Shatto, Cadastral Surveyors, beginning October 13, 1987, and completed September 16, 1991, pursuant to Special Instructions dated September 18, 1987, and Supplemental Special Instructions dated May 9, 1989, under Group Number 1405, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of fir, cedar, pine, yew, larch and alder.
