Chains

I set basalt stone, 17 x 12 x 4 ins., 11 ins. in ground, for Closing Cor. to Secs. 5 & 6, marked C.C., with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. edges and raised mound of stone, 2 ft. high, 4½ ft. base alongside.

Land; rolling.

Soil; 3rd rate.

Scattering pine timber, 73.39 chs.
