paid to them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey into the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land Sixty (60) feet wide, being Thirty (30) feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter

of Section 24 and the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 24, T. 4 N.R. 35 E.T.M. Said center line being described as follows: Beginning at Station 75 / 43 of the Weston Mountain Survey which Station is 292 feet south of the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 24, T. 4 N.R. 35 E.T.M. thence running in a Northwesterly direction 1541 feet to Station 90 / 84 of the said survey, which Station is 112 feet north and 85 feet east of the Southeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 24, Township 4 North, Range 35 East, T.M. Contains 2.13 acres more or less.
