A strip of land, 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the survey as now surveyed;

Beginning at a point approximately 1104 feet west of the SE corner of the NE 1/4 of section 28, Twp. 4N, Range 36, E.W.M., which point is station 56/20.9 on said survey; thence along a tangent with approximate bearing of South 65° 04' for a distance of 482.1 feet to station 61/03, said point being approximately 686 feet west and 225 feet south of the SE corner of the NE 1/4 of Section 28, Twp. 4N, Range 36, E.W.M.

To have and to hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
