Known All Men by These Presents, That William H. Beathe and Barbara Beathe, his wife,

of the County of Umatilla, in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar paid to them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across

All that part of the property of William H. Beathe and Barbara Beathe, his wife, in the East 1/2 of Sec. 30 and the West 1/2 of Sec. 29 Tp. 4 N.R. 36 E.W.M., included within a strip of land sixty (60) feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the Weston Mountain Market Road as surveyed over and across said property and as more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point known and designated as Station O 4 687 which point is approximately 30 feet North of the center of Sec. 30 Tp. 4 N.R. 36 E.W.M.; thence S. 59° 55' E 00 feet; thence on 716.3 foot radius curve to the left 270.0 feet; thence S. 81° 31' E. 196.0 feet; thence on a 573.0 foot radius curve to the left 228.7 feet; thence N. 75° 37' E. 208.2 feet; thence on a 477.5 foot radius curve to the right 395.8 feet; thence S. 56° 00' E. 108.1 feet; thence on a 477.5 foot radius curve to the left 217.6 feet; thence S. 83° 00' E. 905.3 feet; thence on a 358.1 foot radius curve to the left 253.9 feet; thence N. 56° 23' E. 24.3 feet; thence on a 573.0 foot radius curve to the right 253.2 feet; thence N. 81° 42' E. 491.1 feet; thence on a 573.0 foot radius curve to the right 269.0 feet; thence S. 71° 23' E. 430.0 feet to a point known and designated as Sta. 43/27 which point is 166 feet North and 1320 feet west of the Center of Section 29 Tp. 4 N.R. 36 E.W.M.

Also a strip of land 30 feet wide running from the quarter section corner common to sections 29 & 30 T 4 N.R. 36 E.W.M., northerly to intersect the above described Weston Mountain Highway

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
