paid to them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land Sixty (60) feet wide, being Thirty (30) feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the Southeast quarter of the Northwest

quarter of Section 30, Township 4 North, Range 36 East W.M. Beginning at Station 0 / 82 of the Weston Mountain Highway Survey which Station is approximately 1601 feet South and of the quarter corner which is common to Sections 19 and 30 Township 4 North, Range 36 East W.M. Thence running in a Northerly direction approximately 1164 feet to Station 12 / 46 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 548 feet South and 375 feet West of the quarter corner which is common to Sections 19 and 30 Township 4 North Range 36 East W.M., containing 1.60 acres, more or less.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
