The Southwest quarter (S.W. 1/4) of Section 30, and the Northwest quarter (N.W. 1/4) of Section 31 Township 3 North Range 28 East W. M. Beginning at Station 373 + 50 of the Butter Creek Highway Survey which Station is approximately 189 feet North and feet of the 1/4 Corner which is common to Sections 30 and 31 Township 3 North Range 28 East W. M. Thence running in a Southwesterly direction approximately 3160 feet to Station 405 + 10.5 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 1235 feet East of the West 1/4 corner Sections 31 Township 3 North Range 28 East W. M. Containing 4.36 acres more or less

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
