KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The J. E. Smith Lifestock Company, an Oregon Corporation, in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar paid it, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land one hundred feet wide, being fifty feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the following property:

This parcel of land contains 50.48 acres, more or less.

In addition to the above described right of way this deed grants the privilege of obtaining additional road material from any point within 300 feet on either side of said center line.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.

Sturgis and Cecile Sturgis, his wife, of Pendleton, Oregon, in consideration of One (1) Dollar, to them in hand paid by Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, have Bargained and Sold and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey to Umatilla County, State of Oregon, the following described real property, in Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen (15), Township 2 North, Range Thirty-one (31) East, W.M., in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, particularly described as follows:
