A strip of land 20 feet wide being 20 feet on the East side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 6 North, Range 35 East W.M. Beginning at Station 310 + 00 of the Sunnyside Umapine Highway Survey which station is approximately 1771.0 feet North of the Sec. Corner which is common to Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34 Township 6 North Range 35 East W.M. Thence running in a Southerly direction approximately 400 feet to Station 314 + 50 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 1371.0 feet North of the Sec corner which is common to Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34 Township 6 North Range 35 East W.M.
