Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Lot Eleven (11); and running thence East along the Southern Boundary of said Lot a distance of Twenty-four and Three Tenths feet (24.3) thence on a curved line to the left tangent at its point of beginning with said Southern boundary of Lot Eleven (11) and having a radius of Twenty three and nine tenths feet (23.9) a distance of Thirty-seven and Nine Tenths feet (37.9) to the West boundary of said Lot Eleven (11), thence South along the said Western boundary of Lot Eleven (11), a distance of Twenty-four and Three Tenths feet (24.3) more or less to the point of beginning.
