Known as the Ukiah - Albee Section of the Pendleton - John Day Highway

Know All Men by These Presents, That Mary Viebrock and J.P. Viebrock her husband

of the County of Umatilla in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar

paid to them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land 80 feet wide being 40 feet on each side of the center line of said road as surveyed over and across them NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 21, T. 4 S.R. 31 E. W.M. and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at Station 252 / 00 of the said survey which station is approximately 1320 feet north and 1270 feet west of the section corner common to Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28, T. 4 S.R. 31 E.W.M. thence running in a northerly direction 1316 feet to Station 265 / 16 of the survey which station is approximately 1190 feet west of the quarter section corner common to Sections 21 and 22, T. 4 S.R. 31 E.W.M. contains 2.41 acres, more or less exclusive of existing road. In addition to, the land conveyed it is understood that Umatilla County will have the right to borrow material as required in the construction of the road up to and including 300 feet on each side of the above described center line.

To have and to hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
