Thence running in a Northeasterly direction approximately 6535 feet to Station 162 x 35 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 28 feet south of the station corner which is common to Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26 Township 1 South Range 30 E.W.M., said parcel of land containing 9.21 acres, more or less.
