

NOTICE OF HEARING

In the Matter of Proceedings
to Make a Portion of US Forest Service Road No. 3030
a Public Road

NOTICE OF PROCEEDINGS to make a portion of U.S. Forest Service Road No. 3030 (Horseshoe Ridge Road), from its intersection with Old Oregon Trail Highway to its intersection with the original Umatilla Indian Reservation Boundary. The Umatilla County Board of Commissioners has initiated proceedings to make a portion of Horseshoe Ridge Road a Public Road, specifically a local access road, located in Lots 4 and 8, Section 34, Township 1 North, Range 35, East of Willamette Meridian, Umatilla County, Oregon, at its current location, 33 feet on each side of the centerline generally described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the East right-of-way line of State Highway (Old Oregon Trail Highway) and the South line of Section 34, Township 1 North, Range 35; thence northeasterly to a point 321.7 feet North 55°50' East from the quarter corner of said Section 34 and Section 3, Township 1 South, Range 35; thence North 49'52' East 232.6 feet; thence northeasterly to a point on the northerly line of the Bonneville Power Administration easement; thence northwesterly to a point on the original Umatilla Indian Reservation Boundary 1,125.3 feet North 29°44' East of the quarter corner of said Section 34 and said Section 3; All being East of Willamette Meridian, Umatilla County, Oregon.

A hearing will be held on July 3, 2002, at 10:30 a.m., in Room 114, Umatilla County Courthouse, 216 SE 4th Street, Pendleton, Oregon, to consider making the above described portion of U.S. Forest Service Road No. 3030 a Public Road, specifically a local access road, over which the public has a right of use that is a matter of public record. All interested persons may appear at the hearing and present evidence.
