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EAST 2ND STREET (CHARLES TRACTS) ROAD VACATION REPORT

HISTORY

East Second Street is a platted street in the Charles Tracts Subdivision north of Hermiston. It lies approximately 200 feet east of and roughly parallel to U. S. Highway 395. A petition was received from Charlie Kik to vacate that portion of the street lying between Kik Street (now vacated) and Robnett Street. Several other streets and portions of streets in the Charles Tracts Subdivision have already been vacated, probably due to the fact that the property has become more widely used for industrial and commercial purposes than residential, as is stated in the Planning Commission minutes, which are attached.

CURRENT USES

The northerly portion of the street is undulating ground covered with sagebrush and cheatgrass. A travelable road has never been built. The southerly portion lies in a fenced storage area owned by the Petitioner and leased by Production Hydraulics.

PROPERTY OWNERSHIPS

The Petitioner owns all abutting properties. Because Kik Street on the south has already been vacated, no other properties rely on 2nd Street for access.

RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Department recommends that the street vacation be granted based upon the following:

1) There has never been a road constructed within the right-of-way and it has not caused any hardships.


2) The Petitioner owns all abutting property. If he ever sold any of the property he would have to grant them an easement from Robnett Street across his own land anyway.

3) The streets in Charles Tracts were platted assuming it would be a residential area. Because it is used for industrial and commercial purposes, the platted lots are much too small and most tax lots include several subdivision lots; thus not as many streets are needed.

4) Discussions with other property owners indicates they are in favor of the vacation.

<u>Charles Kik Road Vacation</u>. Bob Perry explained that this is a request by Mr. Kik to vacate a portion of East 2nd Street in the Charles Tracts Subdivision north of Hermiston. Originally this was platted for housing back when the dam was constructed; but over the years it ended up being used for industrial and commercial developments. The entire subdivision has numerous streets and roads, several of which have already been vacated due to the industrial and commercial developments requiring larger pieces of land.

The south 262 feet of street proposed for vacation does not consist of an actual developed road on the property. It is situated within the property leased to Production Hydraulics and lies east of the former Northrop building within a fenced storage area. The balance of the street is in sage brush and is not used. The applicant states that the street has never been used as a road and never will be because of the rolling and uneven topography, and because over half of the street lies within this fenced area; and the south end of the street terminates there.

Mr. Perry noted that Charles Kik owns all the property around the proposed vacation site. Staff's initial concern was that this vacation could result some of the adjacent businesses losing access to their properties. However, it was later determined that they would have access from Klaus Lane (a county road) and from East Third Street and Robnett Street (unimproved roads within the subdivision).

By unanimous consensus, the Planning Commission recommended that the Board of Commissioners approve the proposed vacation. It was felt that there were enough existing streets to provide access to the adjacent industrial properties, should these be developed in the near future. The Commission also noted that since Mr. Kik owns all the property around the proposed vacation site, this would address their concern that adjacent landowners who might be affected by the vacation were properly notified and given an opportunity to comment.

<u>Next PC meeting</u>: Is scheduled for Thursday, April 29 at 7:00 pm. It will be held in the newly constructed Justice Center near the Pendleton Airport exit.

ADJOURNMENT:

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 p.m.


