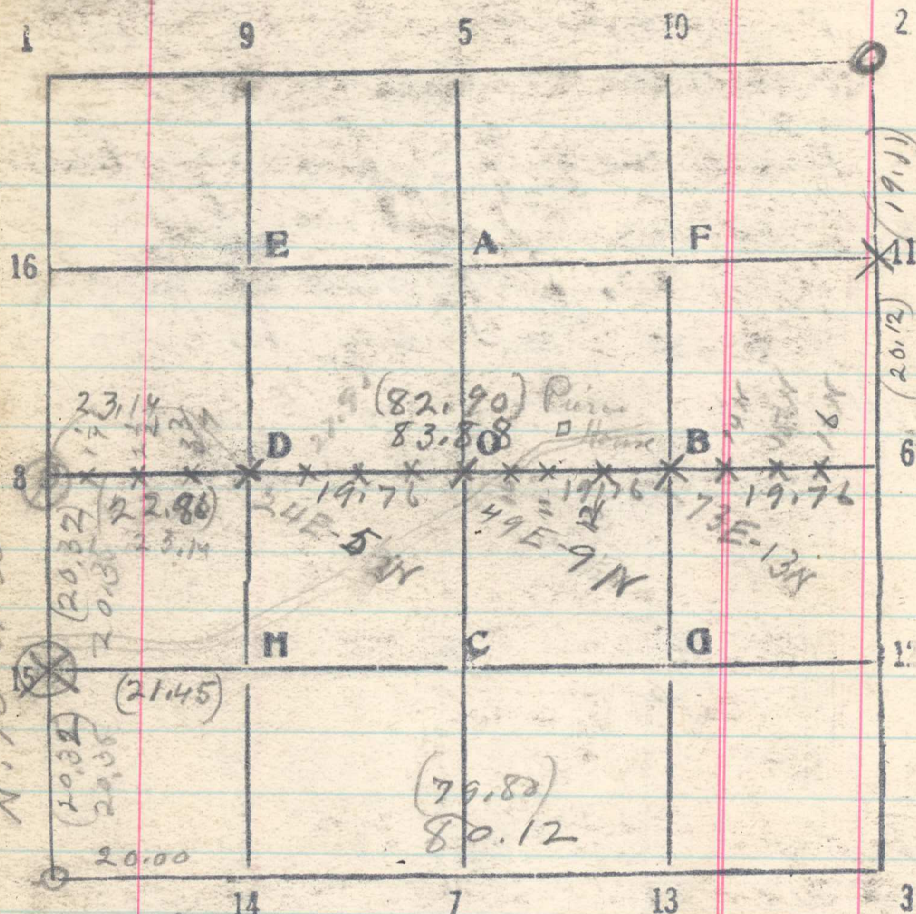

Ch. This corner stake marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 16 on one side, $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 17 on other side, on ground, described as a $\frac{1}{2}$ 241

Pine in old field notes. If find one B.T. a pine 22 beam $N 62^{\circ} E$, 51 lbs. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 17. B.T. marks have been cut out, after being grown over about $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. Evidently not original bearing tree, but marked by some later surveyor.
